

## LRC Meeting Minutes

4/29/24

Call to order: 7:29 pm

Attendance: Kimmy, Wayne, Charis, Kolt, Dick, George, Marlene, Jason and Trina voted via text

Minutes: An amendment was made to the minutes. 10% percent of the net total of the auction proceeds will go to the royalty program (\$2,135.00). 5% (\$1,068.00) will be deposited into the royalty account and 5% (\$1,068.00) will be held back for royalty scholarship money.

Treasurer's Report: The main account has \$53,416.65 and the royalty account has \$1,561.61. \$750.00 was paid out to the Royalty scholarship - it was paid from the main account. The website renewal was \$684.00, it is good for 3 years. The radio ad for chase the ace was \$308.00. Marlene moved to except the treasurer's report, there was a second and the vote passed.

Old Business:

For insurance coverage, we would like to have a work meeting with the town and their lawyer to have some clarification on what is expected. Charis will reach out to Jed and ask for the meeting. The golf course got back to us about their insurance, they pay \$8,300.00 yearly. Kimmy reached out to the Livingston Rodeo; they pay \$4,300.00 yearly.

Stock bids were due. We received a bid from K Bar N Rodeo Company, Bar Lazy C Bucking Bulls, Souzas Bucking Bulls, Dick Gifford and Collingwoods for roping stock. After a ballot vote the bids went to Dick Gifford for rough stock at \$4,150.00 and Collingwoods for roping stock at \$20 an out. Dick did not vote.

Calcutta auctioneer will be John Nation, he said yes.

Rodeo sponsorship letters were mailed in March to pervious donors and they were due on April 20<sup>th</sup>, we have received a few sponsorships back. Sponsorship letters will be mailed in May for new donors. We have 12 buckle sponsorships open, and the stripping chute is still open.

Rodeo vendors so far for this year are Munchies and Broken Desert. Rodeo 307 and a kettle corn vendor will get back to us to confirm their spot. We would like to get our agreement in writing with Get Smashed that they agree to a 90/10 split and they buy the food.

We need more sand for the arena, Kolt will talk to Pat.

The circuit voted on officers they are Billy Fossen – President, Charis Bischoff – Vice President, Melissa Timpany – Secretary and Ronna Collingwood – Treasurer. The circuit opened discussion again for the suggested \$5 circuit fee to all adults per event. There was some disagreement on this from Meeteetse and Ten Sleep rodeo. This discussion has been tabled until after the 2024 circuit finals rodeo for the 2025 season. The next circuit meeting is scheduled for 5/20/24 at 6:30. We need to decide how much money we want to donate as added money to the finals.

New Business:

For the rodeo flyers we would like to include the added money amounts. We are adding \$1000.00 to bulls, saddle bronc, bareback and open ranch bronc; \$500 to youth ranch bronc, women's breakaway, calf roping and youth breakaway; \$300 to youth bulls, barrels, team roping, mixed team roping, youth barrels and steer riding for a total of \$7800.00. Wayne moved to add money to all events for a total of \$7800.00 there was a second the vote passed.

Royalty contest went well. The 2024 Rodeo queen is Ella Pierce and Daisy Carpenter is our 2024 rodeo princess.

We had an inquiry for a Rodeo Clown. After some discussion the club decided not to have a rodeo clown.

The last Monday in May is Memorial Day, Wayne made a motion to move the monthly meeting to May 28, 2024 at the rodeo grounds. There was a second and the vote passed.

The next meeting will be on May 28, 2024 located at the Rodeo grounds at 7:00 pm.
