Meeting minutes were read, Charis moved to make an amendment to the play day. The amendment is that there are currently no set events for the play days that will be held this summer. There was a motion for the amendment and it passed.

Treasurers report. Our main checking account has \$32,447.31. The royalty account has \$361.99. Our sponsorships made \$5350 that's including vendor fees. Marlene move to approve the treasurer's report; there was a second vote taken and passed.

Donation letters have been mailed out banners are \$200 buckles are \$150. We have two possible open slots for buckle donations. Reaching out to a few other sponsors from last year to see if they still want to buy the buckles again this year. Charis will load an updated business list on our Google drive for sponsorships at the end of the meeting.

Stock bids

Before the stock beds were open a motion was moved to to change the age limit for the youth bulls to 17 and younger. There was a second and a vote was taken, the motion passed.

We received three Roughstock beds and two roping beds. The first stock bed was from the Bar Lazy C bucking bulls. They offered bulls at \$35 and out, Jr bulls at \$30 and mini bulls at \$25. They also offered bullfighters each at \$125. The second stock bid was from the K bar N Rodeo. They offered 12 horses at \$80 and out with two pick up men at \$300 each. Our third stock bid was from Dick he had a flat rate fee of \$4600 which included six bulls, six saddle bronc, 12 bareback, five youth bulls, six ranch bronc, two pick up men and bullfighters. Collingwood's bed is for 20 and out for the roping steers and Eadlers is 20 and out for their roping calves.

George moved to except Dick's, Collingwood's an Eadlers bid. A vote was taken the motion passed.
