

LRC MEETING MINUTES

OCTOBER 25, 2021

Call to Order: 7:00 PM

Attendance: Jason, Charis, Melissa, Ashlee, George, Marlene and Trina

Minutes: Previous months minutes were read and approved as read with no amendments.

Treasures Report: Main account we have \$19,919.97 Royalty account has \$379.71. We still have two out standing checks and the Big Horn Radio check came through for 208.08.

Old Business:

Bylaws: Charis Read the bylaws and it says the audit needs to be done by one board of director or one officer that is not the president or treasure (officers that have signing authority on checks).The audit needs to be done once every quarter. Officers will get voted in February making them ready for the 1st quarter audit. Melissa moved that Jason do the 3rd quarter audit and Marlene do the 4th quarter audit. Marlene second the motion, it was voted on and passed.

Vendors: We made \$150.00 from vendors at the rodeo. We were told form our vendors they enjoyed it and would like to come back. We charge the vendors a \$25.00 vendor fee. The fee is not changing.

2022 Rodeo: We need to communicate with the town better, before the rodeo and after the derby on working the ground. Help is always needed the day of the Rodeo. We need to come up with better ways of advertising and how to enter. We need to communicate with the circuit on how we would like to have them help advertise with us. There is a fee online when entering. If we have a contestant who doesn't want to pay the online fee there are other ways for him/ her to pay before the day of the rodeo. Payment options are Venmo, PayPal, card, cash or check. Marlene moved to continue with the online entries a month before the rodeo and call ins to be scheduled for a day roughly a week prior to the rodeo. Ashlee second, a vote was taken, and it passed.

- 1) **Cash Calf:** Went great. Thinking about bringing candy for the little ones who can't catch the calf.

- 2) **Mutton busting:** Give Kids a number for their backs, so we know which kids are in the mutton busting. We have a limited number of sheep and we do not want to wear them out. No buckles for the mutton busting. Trina moved to have 20 kids max ride in the mutton busting. Marlene second, a vote was taken, it passed.
- 3) **Age limit on youth bulls:** Lovell and Cowley are the only ones that offer youth bulls for 16U. The word “Youth” needs to be changed to something more appropriate. Trina moved to change the word Youth to JR. Ashely second, vote was taken, passed. Steer rider cannot be in steers and JR Bulls, just like a senior bull rider can not be in Bulls and in JR Bulls. Can only be in one age group.
- 4) **Ranch Saddle Bronc:** Open to adding an open Ranch Bronc.
- 5) **Royalty:** Ashlee is going to assume royalty director position with Melissa. Ashlee is going to go through the Royalty by laws and rules and present them to the club for any changes that need to be made. Charis moved to have our Royalty contest between the first circuit royalty contest and the first circuit rodeo. There was second made and voted on. Vote passed.

New Business:

- 2) Auction for 2022 is attentively for Feb 12, 2022. Thoughts on Location are the Community Center and the Oasis. We should make a banner and have it posted a week before.
- 3) Youth Rodeo

- 5) Electric eye. George found some electric eyes. Trina moved to let George buy an electric eye up to \$2000.00. There was second, vote was taken, passed.
- 6) Buckles. We voted on buckles for the 2022 rodeo.
