

LRC Minutes

11/24/2025

Call to Order at 7:08pm

Attendance: Devan Q., Cody, Wayne, Charis

**Not enough members in attendance to provide a quorum. All minutes were discussion only.

Minutes: Wayne read the previous months' minutes.

Treasurer's Report: We have \$59,127.93 in our main account and \$642.55 in our Royalty account. All rodeo checks have cleared. Need to touch base with NFR trip winner – that debit card charge for the hotel is still pending. Purchases made and cleared are: 2026 buckles, shelves for storage unit and new roping barrier.

Old Business:

Royalty: Charis reached out to the fairgrounds about renting the indoor arena for the contest and was told we are on the calendar for March 29th; she will follow up regarding if there will be a charge to use the arena.

ADA: No updates

Auction: Event is scheduled for 01/31/2026. The community center has been booked and Andy will be our auctioneer. Garret Linebaugh with WYTEX will cater the event and Aud's 4 Corners will provide the cash bar. Buck Wyold said they are good to be our band again this year for the auction. Updated auction donation list – donations are due by January 15th.

Arena lights: There is a current Black Friday special going for the lights that would offer 15% off and free shipping which is approximately \$1,960. Not enough members present to vote to move forward. Charis did talk to Wayne Brost briefly. He is out of town for the holidays and will get with her to pick up a copy of the quote sent. Sounded positive about the idea. Cody proposed the town to pitch in on a 51% (LRC) and 49% (town) share program.

Rodeo: Announcer - Need to keep looking. Charis reached out to Colby Hales from Riverton, but he is unavailable that weekend. He will send some suggestions. Buckles for 2026 have been ordered. Band – still need to secure a band for after the rodeo.

By-Laws: Not enough members present to do the 2nd reading needed to put in effect for December meeting. Charis will send out a group text for a vote – if it passes, we can stay on track for our December meeting.

New Business

Circuit meeting: Meeting was held on 11/18/25 in Greybull. Membership fees are getting increased to \$40 for every member regardless of youth or adult. This should help eliminate issues on which event they can qualify for. They will continue on a point system as opposed to an earnings system. There will be follow up discussion regarding the point system for the all around winners. Charis was asked to come up with a standardized rodeo results form to present to the rodeo committees to submit to the circuit office. Working on an annual introduction and expectations email to send to the committees at the start of the year to hopefully help with the organization for next year. The finals were set for September 19th in Thermopolis. Event directors discussion was tabled to a later date. No timed stock will be drawn at the finals. Next meeting was set for January 13, 2026 in Greybull at 6:30pm.

Meetings: Holidays are posing a hardship for regular meetings the next couple of months. It was proposed to adjust the next 3 months of meetings to:

December – From the 29th to the 15th

January – From the 26th to the 12th

February - From the 23rd to the 2nd or 9th (?)
