Meeting called to order at 7:29pm

Treasurer's Report (Balance as of 5/31/22 bank statement)-

Main Account: \$35, 328.52

Royalty: \$255.57

Rodeo Financials – everything went fairly well in the office. There were a couple of small hiccups, but they have been fixed and a couple of lessons learned for next year. Gate income was \$4,311. The West Gate made \$2,831 and the East Gate made \$1,480. There were 52 (of 188 sent) sponsors passes redeemed (29 @ West Gate, 23 @ East Gate) and 3 Vendors passes (of 18 sent) and 7 Stock passes (of 18 sent).

Rodeo Review – Kolt & Jason would like to thank Dave Bischoff for allowing us the use of his tractor and fuel to get the arena in shape. The group voted to issue \$200 in credit at the Diamond J Bar for Dave along with sending him a thank you note. In addition, a thank you note will also be sent to Errol Workman along with \$50 cash for all of his extra help behind the bucking chutes. Charis will also write a thank you note to the judges, Cole & Kim for their assistance making everything work last minute in the absence of a no show judge.

Cash Calf – Kolt & Wayne presented a couple of new ideas to keep the cash on the calves in tact. Kolt suggested putting the bills in a Ziploc bag, then gluing it to the calf – Wayne suggested putting the bills in a bank envelope so they cannot see what the bills are. Overall, it seemed like it was well received again this year.

Roping Barriers – there was an issue with the roping barriers for most of the rodeo. Ropers weren't happy with them and 1 breakaway roper was injured during the event. The group discussed using the electric eye barriers for next year.

Looking ahead for next year: We need to review entry fees (do we raise or stay) and how much added money we will put in the pot. Kimmy was nominated as our advertising specialist. It was also discussed to get LRC merch. Charis will speak with Cindy Asay of Wild Edge to get 25 ballcaps made and we can try selling those next year. Other possibilities discussed were shirts (t-shirts and rodeo shirts, to see &/or for club members to wear) and maybe can koozies.

Charis made a motion to get a porta pottie at the arena for the summer months, Jason 2nd, motion passed.
