

LRC Meeting Minutes
8/26/24

Call to order: 7:10 pm

Attendance: Wayne, Jason, Trina, Marlene, Charis, Dick, Cody, Kolt and Kimmy

Marlene read the minutes from the June meeting that was held July 1st. Trina moved to approve the minutes as read, Wayne 2nd – minutes approved.

Treasurer's Report: The main account has \$59,634.83 and the royalty account has \$1,496.10. Keele Sanitation has not sent a bill for the rodeo or the annual porta potty. 10% of Get Smashed sales from the rodeo was \$230.00. We also received the arena refund from the town. We paid Smoking Aces \$1200.00 and Search and Rescue \$1000.00. The net total for the rodeo was \$781.94. We have three outstanding checks, two from the rodeo and one for when the arena was leveled. Wayne will reach out to the leveling company and ask if they will please cash our check. Our net total for Chase the Ace is \$15,149.84.

Carolyn Sharp sent us a thank you card for the nice introduction for the Mustang Days Rodeo along with three checks made payable to each of our royalty girls, Ella, Daisy and Payton. Wayne moved to approve the treasurers report as read, the motion passed.

Old Business:

Charis moved to purchase a 40-foot used car-go-container from Jerry's in Cody, there was 2nd the vote passed. Charis will talk to Jed to make sure the town is still ok with the purchase and ask for the best location to place it.

After some discussion, the club has decided to withdrawal their proposed contract with the town for management of the arena.

There are 26 cards left for Chase the Ace and the progressive pot is currently at \$7,648. We are going into week #29 for the fundraiser.

New Business

The circuit finals are September 14th in Basin at 12:00 pm. The rough stock is coming from K-N and Collingwoods are bringing the roping stock. The circuit is potentially thinking about moving the finals to a Sunday or having the host club pick the time and day. There are gun raffle tickets that need to be sold.

Our yearly auction will be held February 8th. We are planning on moving it to the community center and set up the Friday before. Charis will check with the town and reserve the date if it is available. We will ask for sealed alcohol bids from Diamond J, 4 Corners and the Shoshone. We need to find an auctioneer and January 15th all auction items are due. We

need to look for our “big ticket” items. Charis will reach out to Dan Miller and see about NFR tickets and possibly a hotel stay. Other ideas included a gun safe and a vacation trip.

Wayne has a water truck!!

The queen exit interviews will be after the auction, shooting for March.
