

## LRC Meeting Minutes

4/24/2023

Call to order: 7:03 pm

Mountain Construction is the only place that has sand; its \$17 per ton and \$100.00 for delivery per hour. Jason moved to order a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 4 loads of sand. There was a second, vote taken and the motion passed.

For the Queen contest we need to make sure there is port-o-potty at the arena for next year. The royalty directors would like to give us info about the girls and their season before we have our exit interviews for this coming year.

The town is receptive to our plan for managing the rodeo arena and surrounding grounds.

Stock bids were due tonight. We had two bids for roping stock and four bids for rough stock. Dick was not allowed to vote seeing that one of the rough stock bids was his. A written vote was taken and the results are as followed: 8 votes for Dick, 2 votes for Fox Rough Stock and unanimous for Collingwood's and Edelters. This year's 2023 stock bids went to Dick for rough stock and Collingwoods and Edelters for roping stock.

A reminder sponsorship letter went out a few weeks ago to our sponsors who have not gotten back to us letting them know they have till May 1<sup>st</sup> to have first choice of a buckle or chute. After

May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023, we will be sending out the rest of the sponsorship letters with a letter saying that if they would like to sponsor this year to let us know by May 20<sup>th</sup> 2023.

WRA (Wyoming Rodeo Association) sent us an application, it was filled out and sent back to them. We are co-sanctioning with WRA.

The 2023 Circuit finals are in Lovell. The finals are September 16, 2023. The circuit decided youth can have both youth and adult cards and compete in both for points. The Cody Buckle club has donated to pay the first \$1000.00 entry fees for all rough stock events for all circuit sanction rodeos and the circuit finals. The 2023 circuit officers are:
