

LRC Minutes

03/23/2026

Call to Order: 7:04 pm

Attendance: Kimmy, Charis, Trina, Brenda, Oakley, Jason, George, Wayne, Marlene, Devan Q and Cody.

Minutes: Marlene read the previous months' minutes. There was a motion to approve the minutes as read the motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: There is \$92,659.92 in our main account and \$250.11 in the Royalty account. Taxes for the year 2025 have been submitted. Our deposit from the community center came back minus \$30.00 (\$270). Our final net income from the Auction is \$36,051.31. 10% of this total will go to the royalty. \$1803.00 will go into the royalty account and \$1803.00 will be held back for the scholarship awards for the 2026 Royalty. Charis researched CD options for the club & presented several choices. Trina moved to approve the treasurer's report.

Old Business

Trina moved to put 25 thousand dollars into a 6-month CD and in 3 months to look and see if we can put another 25 thousand dollars in another 6-month CD. There was a second and the motion passed. The CD will be made at First Bank of Wyoming. Charis Bischoff (treasurer) and Wayne Curtis (president) will be on the CD. If there is to be another CD in three months' time, both Charis and Wayne will be on that CD as well.

Royalty exit interviews were held before the meeting. From the 2025 Auction we have \$1243.00 to give to our Queen and Princess for their yearly scholarship. After both interviews and some discussion, we agreed to award our 2025 Queen Daisy Carpenter \$600.00 and our 2025 Princess Oakley Bischoff \$400.00. Jason moved to award scholarships. There was a second and the motion passed.

Our 2026 Royalty contest will be Sunday March 03/29/2026 at 4:00 pm at the indoor arena in Basin. So far, we have 5 princess applications and 1 queen application. There will be around 50 people there to cook for. John and Brenda said they would make sloppy Joes, Wayne and Kimmy will cook brats; the club will be purchasing buns. Daisy and Oakley will be able to keep their crowns from their 2025 Royalty season.

Charis moved to remove the ADA bathroom from the agenda for the time being, keeping in mind this topic can be revisited. There was a second and the motion passed.

Arena lights: Wayne and Jason both attended the motor sports board meeting last month. The motor sports board agreed to supply and install the posts for the lights. LRC is responsible for the

installation, maintenance and management of the lights. If LRC dissolves or moves, the lights come with us. Cody will ask for an updated quote with a total of 25 lights.

Stock Bids will be posted this Thursday (3/26/26). They are due by April's meeting.

2026 Rodeo

Port-O-Potties need to be ordered for the summer and fall. Along with an ADA port-o-potty. For our vendors this year we would like to have 5 all serving different types of foods. So far, we have WYTEX, Get Smashed, and Top Dawg. We would like to get 2 more. We will look into the new Mexican food-based food truck and one other. We will have a new photographer for the rodeo. We did let her know that we typically do not pay for a photographer during the rodeo. She will need to sell the photos on her own. Cole Linebaugh will be our judge this year. Sam has something else going on that day so we asked Cory. He is not sure but will look at his calendar and let us know by the end of the week if he is available. For a dance/ band after the rodeo Jason will reach out to the Cowley Boys and see if they are available and what their rate is etc. We were approved to disk a warm up area last year. We need to move forward on getting this completed.

New Business

Ducks Unlimited asked for a basket donation from us. At this time, we have declined donating to organizations that are not rodeo based and within our surrounding areas.

Wyoming High School Rodeo Association reached out to us for a sponsorship for the WHS rodeo Finals that will be held in Buffalo. Marlene moved to have Charis see if a barrel cover is available for purchase as our first choice. If not, then we would like a chute gate sponsorship for our second choice and our third choice would be a buckle and event award sponsorship. There was a second and the motion passed.

Our first round of sponsorship letters were stuffed during the meeting and will be mailed.

Deadline for first round donors is April 20th.

Currently there are no circuit updates. The next meeting is tomorrow (3/24/26) at 6:30 in Greybull.

Motor Sports board had discussed a dance floor to be built for the rodeo grounds. They are going to put a rubber mat around the bottom of the round pen to help keep the sand in. They are also going to get more sand for the round pen. They have to redo the ADA bleacher section as it did not pass inspection. Wayne has been officially appointed to the board.

It was asked if we would be willing to rent our sound equipment to the FFA. After discussion, we agreed we are not comfortable renting the equipment out to anyone at this time.
